WORK COMMENCES ON THE PARNKALLA TRAIL WHARF PRECINCT UPGRADE

Work has commenced on the first stage of the redevelopment of the Parnkalla Trail Wharf Precinct. The first stage consists of constructing an exposed aggregate concrete footpath and new fencing through the existing carpark and a footbridge across the historical Troubridge Ferry docking point. The wharf area remains open to recreational users with signage directing an alternative route through the wharf and grain marshalling area.
