MAKE A DIFFERENCE NOMINATE FOR COUNCIL FROM 4 SEPT

Nominations for the 2018 Local Government Elections open Tuesday 4 September and close at 12 noon on Tuesday 18 September 2018.

To become a candidate a nomination form must be completed and lodged with Council during this period. Candidates will be required to complete and lodge the required nomination material, which includes a 150 word candidate profile and an optional 'head shoulders' photograph either via the on-line nomination portal or pre-printed nomination form available from the Council Administration Office.

It is strongly recommended that all nominations be lodged well before the closing date to allow for the nominations to be checked, and time for any corrections to be made by the candidate and then resubmitted before the nomination closing time - no corrections will be accepted after 12 noon on Tuesday 18 September 2018.

If you would like more information about nominating to be a candidate, the Electoral Commission of SA Candidate Handbook provides a detailed explanation of eligibility criteria, the nomination process and election process.
