CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTOR APPOINTED FOR LEISURE CENTRE STADIUM EXPANSION

Council has appointed Unique Urban Built Pty Ltd, a South Australian based company, as the Construction Contractor for the Port Lincoln Leisure Centre Stadium Expansion. This is the third and final stage of the \$9.41million redevelopment of the Port Lincoln Regional Leisure Centre being jointly funded by the Australian Government and Council.

Site establishment works are planned to start in late September 2018 with construction works scheduled to be completed in June 2019.

Council will be working with stakeholders to ensure the planned expansion works does not adversely impact the users of the Stadium and access to the Gym will be maintained throughout the construction.
