RECYCLING TIPS

What items should I put into my household recycling bin?



DRINK & FOOD CARTONS such as milk, custard, juice, stock and fruit boxes.

Drink and Food cartons should be rinsed so that they don't become smelly. You can also squash them down so they don't take up too much room in your recycle bin.

The foil lining and plastic funnels on cartons do not need to be removed as these will be removed during the recycling process.

All lids should be removed and placed into your waste bin.
