The Electoral Commission SA will be posting out voting materials for the 2018 Council Elections from Monday 22 October to Friday 26 October 2018.

The ballot paper in your voting pack will show the candidates standing for election in your Council area. Once you complete your ballot paper make sure you return it in the reply paid envelope as soon as possible to ensure the Electoral Commission of South Australia receives it **before 5pm on Friday 9 November 2018.**

If you do not receive a voting pack and you are on the State (House of Assembly) Roll or Council's supplementary roll you will need to contact the Electoral Commission SA to request the issue/re-issue of voting materials.
