## LIVERPOOL AND EYRE STREET PUMP STATION PROJECT

The existing Liverpool Street pump station is scheduled for replacement, with a new pump station to be built in Eyre Street. The new pump station will minimise the flood impacts in the Liverpool Street and Eyre Street area as well as providing a compatible system to the wider City of Port Lincoln stormwater network.

Council has engaged the services of Lucas Total Contract Solutions to undertake the construction program with works scheduled to start in the coming weeks and is planned for completion by June 2019, weather permitting.

There will be road restrictions in place throughout the project with the public asked to take care when in this area.

## BEACH GOERS REMINDED TO BE AWARE OF POSSIBLE RAZOR FISH ON OUR BEACHES

Council has installed warning signage at Mundy's Mooring, North Point Beach, Snook's Landing and along the foreshore area as these areas have been identified in the past as having razor fish. The public are to exercise caution in these areas as razor fish are very sharp and can cause painful cuts to the feet.

While the Port Lincoln Leisure Centre Stadium Expansion project is being undertaken the western car park next to the Basketball Stadium has been closed off. To alleviate parking congestion and inconvenience to private land owners, Council has arranged alternative parking behind the Centre.
