## COMMUNITY LIAISON OFFICERS ACTIVELY MONITORING PARKING IN THE CBD

Council's Community Liaison Officers will be actively monitoring and enforcing parking in the CBD area in the lead up to the busy festive season.

The Community Liaison Officers will be marking up on-street time zones to ensure that the public do not overstay the determined time limit, as well as monitoring bus and loading zones, disabled parks, no parking zones, and other types of parking offences.

If you are caught doing the wrong thing you are committing an offence which may result in an expiation notice. It is a driver's responsibility to take note of the time zones and abide by the Australian Road Rules at all times—you don't want to be receiving an expiation, especially at this time of year.

***Stick to the on-street parking rules and time limits within the designated areas and you will avoid an expiation***

## ALTERNATIVE PARKING AT THE PORT LINCOLN LEISURE CENTRE



While the Port Lincoln Leisure Centre expansion project is underway users accessing the Leisure Centre are asked to refrain from parking on private property and the Marina Hotel car parks.

## ORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING DATES

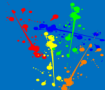
