TOILET FACILITY AND NEW IRRIGATION SYSTEM AT THE TRAIN PARK

Work has commenced on a toilet facility and new irrigation system at the Train Park located at the corner of New West Road and Stuart Terrace that will improve the amenity of the park.

A unisex accessible public toilet (similar to the new North Quay Boulevard Toilet) will be built at the rear of the park adjacent the shelter, providing a much needed rest stop for users of both the park and the Heritage Trail.

An irrigation system with leak detection and remote monitoring and operation is also being installed to keep the grass healthy all year round.

The Project is expected to be completed by mid-march. Access to some areas of the park will be restricted at times during construction to maintain public safety. We appreciate your understanding and patience for any inconvenience this may cause while the work is being undertaken.

LEISURE CENTRE EXPANSION PROJECT TEMPORARY STADIUM AND GYM CLOSURE

STREETScape WORKS TO COMMENCE ALONG PORTER STREET



The undergrounding of the overhead mains in Porter Street (Dublin Street Bridge to London Street) has now been completed.

Contractor Groundwork Landscaping will commence the street scaping works along Porter Street from Dublin Street to London Street from Monday 11 February 2019.

The works will include paving of footpaths, installation of tree cell matrix systems for the planting of established trees and some minor kerb repairs. The works are expected to take approximately 8 to 10 weeks.

Access to properties in the area may be restricted at times. The Contractor and Council will endeavour to undertake the works with minimal disruption as possible.
