RECYCLING TIPS

What household items should I be putting in my household recycling bin?

All **RIGID PLASTIC CONTAINERS** such as chocolate and biscuit trays, detergent bottles, cleaning product and spray bottles, drink bottles, shampoo, conditioner and cosmetic bottles, yogurt, ice-cream and butter tubs.

It is recommended that you rinse all containers before placing the items into your household recycling bin.

The larger plastic lids can be placed into your household recycle bin and the small plastic bottle lids should go into your waste bin.
