COMMUNITY GRANT FUNDING PROGRAM OPEN



The Community Grant Funding Program is currently open to the community to apply for grant funding to support eligible local events, projects, programs and activities being held in the next 12 months.

Funding can be applied for under the following categories:

- **Group** - Funding up to \$300
- **Local** - Funding up to \$1,000
- **Regional** - Funding of \$1,001-\$2,000 (including any Council in-kind support)
- **Major** - Funding of \$2,001 and above on a case by case basis (including any Council in-kind support)

To apply, applicants must complete the appropriate form relevant to their funding category available on Council's website at www.portlincoln.sa.gov.au/grantfunding or a hardcopy can be obtained from the Council Administration Office during normal business hours.

Funding applications must be received by Council by 5pm on Friday 26 April 2019
