EYRE STREET STORMWATER PUMP STATION CONSTRUCTION TO COMMENCE

Construction of the Eyre Street Stormwater Pump Station is set to start this week with the project expected to be completed by the end of the year.

Traffic control requirements will be put in place which will limit access in the vicinity of and through Eyre Street between Tasman Terrace and Liverpool Street. As the project progresses, the traffic restrictions will be progressively changed to suit the work phases of the project.

Eyre Street will be closed to the public from Wednesday 8 May 2019 until the completion of the project.

A traffic management plan is available for your information on our website at www.portlincoln.sa.gov.au/pumpstation.

The first phase of the works involves the installation of steel sheet piles to be driven into the ground within Eyre Street. The sheet pile installation is set to commence on Sunday 19 May 2019 and take approximately two weeks to complete.

We are aware that the works to be carried out will be noisy and the closure of Eyre Street will cause some inconvenience to traffic management in this area and appreciate the public's cooperation and understanding while the works are being carried out.
