Reminder that the Foreshore, CBD and Marina Precinct Community Co-Design Workshops kicks-off Thursday 6 December 2018.

The City of Port Lincoln is looking forward to this Thursday December 6 and Friday December 7 as the community come together with Council's master plan consultants Jensen Plus to re-imagine the Foreshore, CBD and Marina precincts.

Chief Executive Officer Stephen Rufus said "The precinct master plans will establish a shared vision for the long-term future of the City".

"We invite the community to be involved throughout the master planning process, as we work with a highly talented group of planning and design experts to produce outstanding master plans for our three key precincts and detailed design work for the foreshore in particular," Mr Rufus said.

"This is a fantastic opportunity to strengthen the city through liveability, tourism, recreation and economic development while preserving and making visible our culture and historic character".

"The master plans will include input from community, industry, neighbouring Councils, Regional Development Australia Whyalla and Eyre Peninsula and the South Australian Tourism Commission".

Mayor Brad Flaherty said "Already the social media feedback has been tremendously positive with excellent suggestions on nature play spaces for children, permanent event infrastructure and public realm improvements to spruce up our retail and trading strips".

"I would urge everyone who is interested in the future of this iconic City to visit one of the open studio co-design workshops and have their say," Mr Flaherty said.

Information collected at the co-design sessions will feed into the preparation of Draft Precinct Master Plans and detailed designs for the foreshore environs. Stakeholders will be able to put forward their vision for the future of the City of Port Lincoln and contribute to setting the direction of the master planning process.
