# COMMUNITY TO VOTE FOR THEIR FAVOURITE LOCAL PROJECTS

The City of Port Lincoln invites the community to vote for their favourite local projects submitted by locals in Round One of the State Government's \$40 million Fund My Neighbourhood Program.

Voting is now open. People are able to vote on ideas within a 5km radius of their residential address. To be eligible to vote you need to Log in or Register for a YourSAy account, must be 18 years or over and live in South Australia.

Voting can only be completed online on the Fund My Neighbourhood website [www.fundmyneighbourhood.yoursay.sa.gov.au](http://www.fundmyneighbourhood.yoursay.sa.gov.au) and requires verification via your mobile phone.

There are a number of local projects submitted which required Council support. Some of the ideas include:

- Mundy's Mooring Reserve Restroom
- Toy and Sporting Equipment Library
- Fencing for the Port Lincoln Hockey Association Turf
- Lincoln City Dog Park, Off-Leash Socialisation & Exercise Area
- Nature Play at Rustler's Gully Playground
- Nelson Square Children's Playground and Surrounds
- Train Playground public toilet block
- Port Lincoln in January
- Computer Literacy Education Equipment for the Port Lincoln Community

Mayor Bruce Green said, "I encourage people to register to vote as this is a great opportunity for people to vote for their top three to five projects that may benefit them and others in the community. Make your vote count and help decide which ideas will receive funding, don't leave it up to someone else".

For those that do not have access to the internet, the Port Lincoln Library has made available a computer so that people are able to submit their vote. The staff will be on hand to assist anyone who needs help.

Voting closes 5pm on Monday 20 November 2017.
