# Port Lincoln Leisure Centre

The City of Port Lincoln was informed this morning that Paul Jorgensen, a Partner at PKF Adelaide, has been appointed as liquidator in relation to Unique Urban Built Pty Ltd. UUB is currently engaged as the head contractor for the Council's Leisure Centre Stadium Expansion project.

The Council is currently working with Mr Jorgensen with a view, if possible, to ensuring that the project is completed by UUB, together with its local subcontractors, on time and on budget.

The project is the second and final stage of the \$9.41million redevelopment of the Port Lincoln Regional Leisure Centre, which is being jointly funded by the Australian Government and Council, and is scheduled for completion in July 2019.

The project site is currently closed, and it is expected that it will remain closed for the next 48 hours. Subcontractors should contact Robert Spiby of PKF Adelaide to obtain updates on operational matters relating to the project.

Mayor Brad Flaherty said, "It is a challenging period for UUB, their employees and subcontractors, as well as for the Council due to the significance of the project to the Council and the region. The Council hopes to be able to find a swift resolution, with Mr Jorgensen if possible, which gives the best outcome to those people, many of whom are local to Port Lincoln and the Eyre Peninsula, as well as to all stakeholders in the Stadium Expansion of the Leisure Centre. We are in close contact with Mr Jorgensen and his representatives to identify the best way forward and will update the community and the stakeholders when we know more."

Paul Jorgensen said, "We are at a very early stage in this process, but I am hopeful that I will be able to work with the Council to bring the Leisure Centre Stadium Expansion project to completion."
