FUTURE OF THE ARTEYREA FACILITY



The City of Port Lincoln is undertaking a review of the Port Lincoln Arteyrea facility and the services being provided to the community and invites feedback through a community survey. Responses received from stakeholder groups and the community survey will be used as a basis for recommendations for the future of the building. The Council is committed to arts and cultural facilities and activities that provide opportunities for the community to celebrate, engage and participate in creative and artistic endeavours.

The community survey aims to provide Council with an indication of the functionality of the Arteyrea facility, if it is meeting the needs and expectations of the community and whether there are any improvements that can be made to the operations and services currently being provided.

Mayor Bruce Green said, “The Arteyrea building is an important facility that currently provides a space for creative and artistic endeavours, and the review of the facility and its services will assist in determining the future of the facility to meet the changing needs of the community.”
