

Help protect SA's oyster industry

SA's oysters are safe to eat, but do not use Pacific Oysters, oyster shells, or seafood sold for human consumption (including imported seafood) as **bait or berley** - **do not discard** or **store** in the ocean.



Under the *Fisheries Management Act 2007*, it is an offence to release or deposit exotic fish, aquaculture fish, or fish kept apart from their natural habitat into South Australian waters.

Maximum penalty of up to \$120,000 applies.
